Presidential Inauguration Training- On December 21st, Serve DC held the second Inauguration training for all CERT trained volunteers and others interested in volunteering at the World Mission Society Church. Approximately 70 volunteers attended. Peggy Keller and Sharon Pellig, from DOH presented specific information and staffing selections on sheltering, warming centers, points of dispensation PODS and family reunification.

World Aids Day - Serve DC honored World Aids Day by hosting its annual World Aids Day Food Drive from December 1st-9th. Serve DC partnered with the Mayor's Office on Community Relations and Services, DCHR, DC Office on Aging and the Department of Motor Vehicles. 406.5 pounds of food were collected and were delivered to Food and Friends. Also, over 1400 bags filled with HIV awareness information were distributed to various neighborhoods such as Shaw-Howard, Columbia Heights and Anacostia.
