## **DPR Food Recovery Program**

40% of all the food we grow in the US ends up in the dump. Yet roughly one in seven DC families are experiencing food insecurity.

### **Want to Join the Solution?**

Join DC Parks and Rec (DPR) and Food Rescue US this summer to help recover perfectly good meals from the DPR Summer Meals program and delivery them to local food pantries.

### **How Does it Work?**

DPR will be partnering with Food Rescue US to use their app to coordinate volunteers to transport food donations to the nearest food pantry. There's no commitment to sign up and once a participant is signed up you can choose which food transportation job you want to help with each week. Once you choose a "food pickup" Food Rescue US will send you all the details you need for picking up and dropping off.

### **How to Participate?**

It's easy to join! Just download the app at [foodrescue.us](http://foodrescue.us) or find food rescue in the App Store. Don't like apps? You can register online at [foodrescue.us](http://foodrescue.us) without any apps. Once registered, log in and check out which "food pickups" are ready for volunteers and choose the one that works best for you.

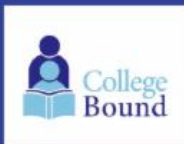
